## Our Mission

New Jersey Solidarity is a grassroots organization dedicated to resistance and action in support of the Palestinian struggle for justice, national liberation, human rights and self-determination. We are dedicated to building coalitions, educating the public, spreading awareness, and organizing actions and events that highlight the pressing need for justice in the Middle East and spotlight ways in which we, as concerned observers, may take part in securing a true peace with justice. We are committed to the full implementation of international law in compliance with all applicable United Nations resolutions.

We stand in support of three primary principles:

### END TO OCCUPATION:

We call for an immediate end to the Israeli occupation of the Palestinian territories; the prerequisite for peace is the complete withdrawal of the Israeli military and settler populations from the West Bank and Gaza.

### RIGHT OF RETURN:

We support the inalienable and unnegotiable human right of return of Palestinian refugees, as outlined in the 4th Geneva Convention.

### EQUALITY UNDER LAW:

We oppose the denial of political, social, and economic rights in law and practice to the Palestinian citizens of Israel, and stand against all forms of oppression at home and abroad. Democracy cannot exist through racism.

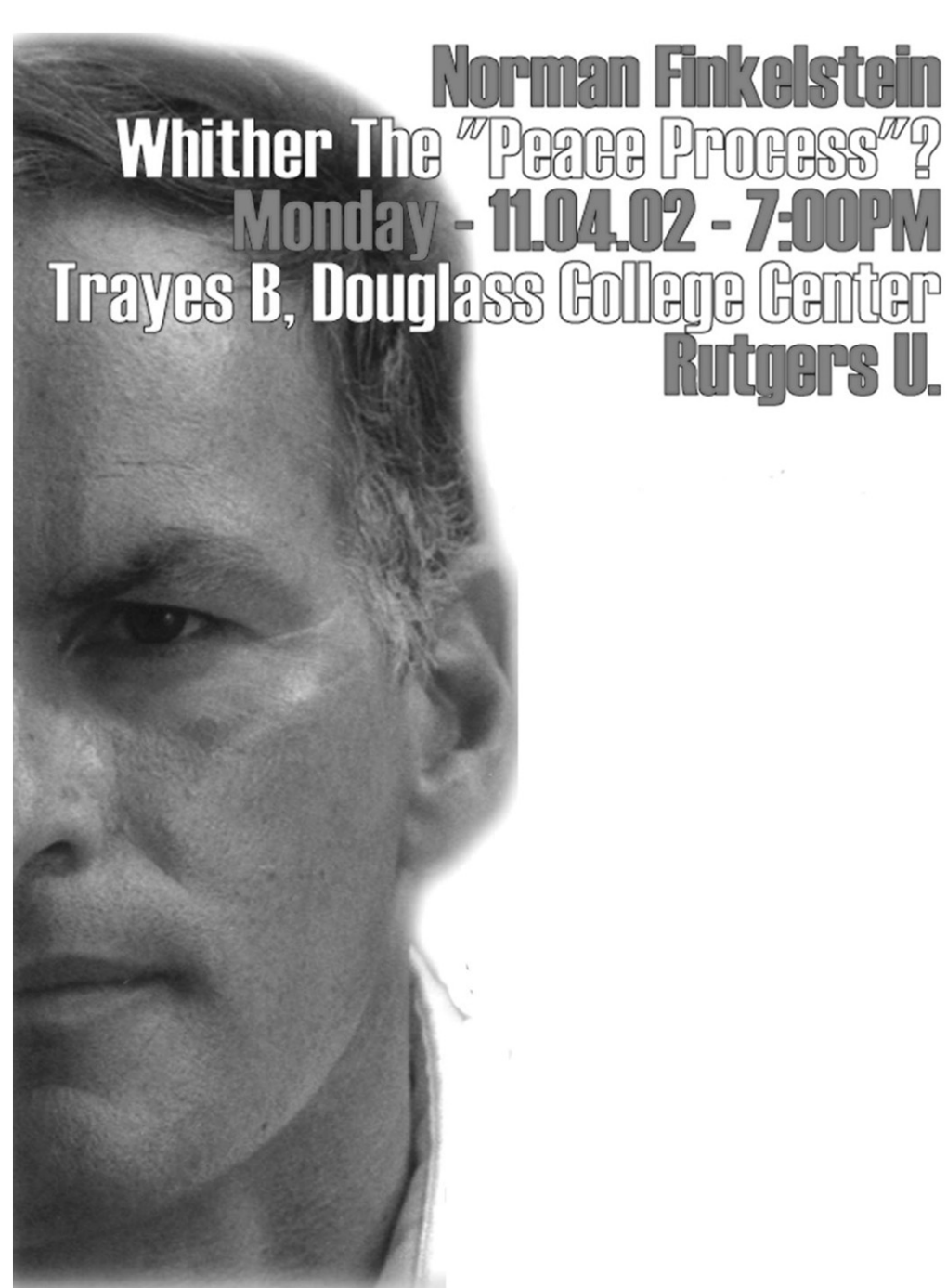
