



Reportback from Palestine

Featuring: ERICA WEITZMAN traveled to the West Bank this past summer with other JATO members as part of the International Solidarity Movement's "Freedom Summer" campaign. Born in Washington, D.C., she has also lived in Boston, Paris, and Kosovo. She currently lives in New York City.

RYAN SENSER traveled to Palestine with other members of JATO in August to work with Palestinian organizers and other activists from Europe, North America, and Japan under the auspices of the International Solidarity Movement. Only a decade ago, he participated in a pro-Zionist tour of Israel, an experience he has now revisited and rethought extensively. He is a former College Hillel President and led a delegation of Jewish college students to Germany as part of a pilot dialogue program in 1995. He has served as a Hebrew and Religious School teacher in the Jewish communities in which he has lived.

Born in Jerusalem and the daughter of a rabbi, ORA WISE has worked with rabbis for human rights with bedouins in West Bank. She co-founded a Palestine solidarity organization at Ohio State University and helped organize the Second National Student Conference on the Palestine Solidarity Movement. She recently participated in the Palestine Truth Tour and currently teaches Jewish studies at a synagogue in Brooklyn.

LOUISA SOLOMON participated in the ISM Freedom Summer campaign in August 2002. Alongside Palestinian non-violent organizers, she was injured by the Israeli army while staging a peaceful demonstration in the Palestinian town of Huwwara, near Nablus.
