We've Come Undone explores how we relate, and struggle to relate to one another now. What happens when lies and suspicion are allowed to permeate the fabric of our society and embed into the weave? How does that affect our behavior and who we become, individually and as a society? We've Come Undone seeks to gather those loose ends, allowed to dangle for so long, and re-introduce them into the cultural dialogue through theater.
